### **Kevin Richards, Sports Artist**

Randy introduced Kevin Richards who is an art teacher for Greene County Schools in Jefferson, Kevin is a 1981 graduate of Boone High ("Mr. Hutcheson" was his principal) and then attended DMACC for a few years (where Mr. McNair was one of his instructors!). He subsequently got a degree in art from Iowa State. Kevin shared that although he is well-versed in many forms of "art" his particular expertise is in drawing. Back in 1990 he began doing pencil drawings of sports figures, starting with Don Mattingly (who happened to be his favorite player). After finishing his drawing he took it to Indiana to Don Mattingly's restaurant. He happened to be there and signed the drawing for Kevin. Kevin indicated that drawing is still one of his favorites and he now has around 40 autographed drawings framed in his home. Kevin noted that his style has evolved from single figures (like the Don Mattingly work) to "collages" with multiple images of the athletes engaged in various activities. He showed works he had done of Fred Hoiberg, Kevin Bryant, Georges Niang and, in a departure

from sports figures, singer James Taylor. He indicated that he can invest up to 80 hours in drawing one of the works, noting that he "draws slowly" so any mistakes are "small"! The drawings are pretty amazing and Randy has donated three works for our auction including prints featuring Georges Niang, Kris Bryant, and Tom Brady. Thanks to Randy for a fascinating program and for his generous donations to our auction!
