Pres. Pete began by expressing his appreciation for the support of the entire club over the past year, and in particular to members of board who provided their help and guidance along the way. In one of his final acts as president Pete did say we had his permission to remove the bows from our name badges (the bows having served as a reminder that this year's theme was "Be a Gift to Rotary"! Pete shared that our club had a number of very successful fundraisers including the Pulled Pork Dinner which raised over \$5000 and our recent auction which probably (the final numbers aren't quite determined) raised around \$15,000. Pete highlighted that our fundraising efforts allowed us to support a host of great projects including \$6750 in scholarships, the dictionary project, FAMSCO (Fire and Medical Supply Company), MOST (Miles of Smiles Team, Y Camp scholarships, Little League Sponsorship, the Pufferbilly Spelling Bee, and Operation Warm that provided coats to 96 students in need. Pete thanked Amy for all her work in writing the District Matching Grant proposal that will result in five AEDs (defibrillators) being donated to the Boone Schools, Lisa for coordinating Operation Warm, Mary for co-chairing the Pulled Pork Dinner, and Abby for all her efforts as chair of Rotary Auction. Pete also highlighted that

our club received 100% Paul Harris recognition AND was recognized as the volunteers of the year by the Iowa Sports Foundation for our years of serving as road marshals of the Iowa Games Cycling race. We are proud that Isidro is going to be serving as a RYLA Counselor and traveling to Italy as RYE student and we all enjoyed having Inga from Norway with us a RYE this past year.
