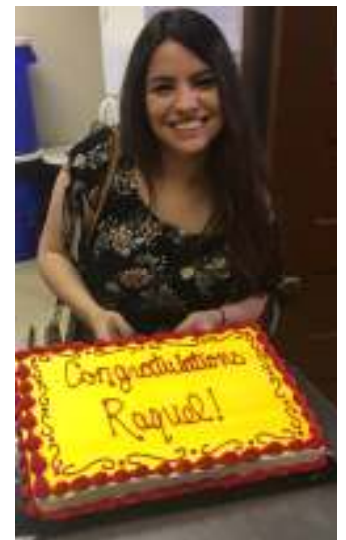
## Meeting Recap

Steve Dakin presented the program about – “ROTARY” He started with a quiz with prizes--a Rotary golf towel with the new slogan for 2017/18 “Rotary – People of Action”. Steve shared that there is no such thing as the “Rotary Police” – meaning we can make our Rotary Club anything we want to. One of the reasons he retired was to have more time to “give back”, especially to Rotary. He enjoyed the Rollin’ with Rotary tour and informed us the future of Rotary is in very good hands with the younger generation. Steve indicated that he would like to see every new member coupled with a “Rotary mentor” to help get and keep them engaged and involved in Rotary.

A new concept that RI will be implementing in the future is **Start – Stop – Continue.**

**Continue** – We can choose to continue any project we already have.

He stated that the millennials joining Rotary would like to implement monthly statements so budgeting is easier. He would like us to think about that. He also passed out Rollin with Rotary “Random Act of Kindness” cards and would like us to consider something similar with Rotary Club of Boone on them to make our club more visible. He encouraged each member to attend other club’s weekly meetings to get ideas that we could try. In his travels, each club is so different with many ideas.
