George introduced Bill Skare who became the Boone City Administrator last October. Prior to that Bill had served as the Chief of Police /Public Safety Director for several years and he also served an earlier stint on the Boone PD back in the 1990's. Bill highlighted some of the big projects underway or being considered in the community including a new 50 unit housing development that would cost about \$8.5 million. The hope is that some seniors would move from their homes to this new development from their current homes, thereby increasing the stock of homes available for younger families to purchase. There are also plans and capital fundraising underway to build a new hotel/convention facility. Boulders management is trying to raise the necessary capital locally for this project which would include a 44 bed hotel and meeting area/convention area that could seat over 400. Work is underway on some paving projects including resurfacing Benton St. and eventually paving Quartz Avenue leading north out of the Industrial Park. The road in

McHose park also needs attention and will get an overlay next year. Discussions still take place about a possible viaduct on Highway 17 that would connect to the Industrial Park. Bill mentioned that the city is in the process of updating its phone system and website. He also touched on some of the rationale for the city considering starting its own ambulance service. Thanks to Bill for an interesting update about what is going on in Boone!
