Brad introduced Boone High School Principal Kris Byam and Director of Innovative Learning Jill Janes who presented a program on the Boone EDGE Program. EDGE stands for *Empowering-Desire-Guiding-Experience*. Mr. Byam shared that the goal of the program was to increase the awareness of students about vocational and career opportunities and to develop even stronger connection between the school and the community. They noted that Kurt and Chamber have been very supportive in providing opportunities for students to visit various businesses in the community. EDGE is a work based learning model that involves students at the elementary, middle school, and high school levels and strives to help them develop the core skills needed for post-secondary success including communication, collaboration, adaptability and forward thinking, cultural and global awareness, self-awareness, and professionalism and employability skills. Students gain increased awareness of career opportunities, have the opportunity to gain greater understanding of what various vocational and career opportunities involve, and even have the opportunity to gain valuable real-

world work experience while still in school. Mr. Byam noted that they have established a pre-apprenticeship program with Kruck Plumbing and the Builders and Contractors of Iowa that have enabled students to learn skills and even receiving some certifications.
