## Wade Hiner, Destiny Homes

Becky Dose introduced Wade Hiner of Destiny Homes. Wade noted that he has been a Rotarian in the Cedar Rapids area for 25 years himself! Wade said he became aware of Boone when he saw Becky on the TV news talking about the lack of housing inventory to sell in the Boone area a year or so ago. He reached out to Becky to see if his company could alleviate that problem and she in turn put him in contact with the city of Boone. Wade shared that Destiny Homes began in 2009 and since that time they have constructed over 100 new homes (now averaging close to 200 a year) in communities across Iowa. In Boone they will be building 17 of their S.M.A.R.T. series homes on lots located near the Little League Park. The homes come in different designs but owners must select among 8 "outdoor" packages (shingles, colors, masonry) and 8 indoor packages (cabinets, flooring, etc.) The homes have costs around \$197-230,000 and have between 1000 and 1800 square feet of living space. Monthly payments typically run between \$900 to a little less than \$1100 per month. Wade noted that

by using a variety of standard designs and packages they are able to keep the costs low and they are also able to complete construction within 60 days in many instances. The homes are very well constructed and are also rated at Energy Star levels of efficiency. We can look forward to seeing many new homes in the Boone in the coming months!
