Tim Trudeau began by sharing that he shares with visitors to Boone that the Boone Hope Foundation is one of the jewels in our community. He introduced board members Rhonda Getschman and MaryAnn Moglestad to share about the Foundation. Rhonda is retired teacher and Mary Ann is a retired school nurse. They were happy to see that most members are familiar with the Hope Foundation and have attended the Festival of Hope in the past. This year's festival will be Dec. 7<sup>th</sup> in the commons area at Boone High. Rhonda shared that the Hope Foundation was established 15 years ago after staff participated in an in service session about students living in poverty. They recognized that there was a significant need to support children and families living in poverty or experiencing life changing events like the loss of a job or health issues. In 2018 the Hope Foundation distributed \$64,583 to 131 families (242 kids) with 40% going to support housing needs, 36% to utilities, 12% for transportation help, 6%

for food, and 5% for clothing. Since the inception of the Foundation they Hope Foundation has distributed a total of \$596,399 in support of Boone children and their families. MaryAnn and Rhonda expressed their appreciation for all the support our club and members have provided to the Hope Foundation through the years.
