Andrew introduced Diana Byriel who Technology Integration is the Specialist for the Boone elementary Diana noted that her schools. involves working position with teachers to help them effectively integrate technology into instruction. She is also very involved in STEM (science technology engineering and math) training with the elementary teachers. Diana works with teacher to utilize computers and other forms of technology to enhance student learning. She was very pleased to report that the Boone Schools recently were notified that they would be receiving a \$50,000 grant for the state of Iowa as part of the Computer Science is Elementary initiative. The goal is to increase student learning and problem solving skills by teaching things like coding, IT concepts, networking, and increasing awareness about careers in the area of technology.
